



"General Conference"

General Conference (GC) is the highest legislative body of The United Methodist Church (The UMC). It sets policy for The UMC and is the official voice of our denomination. It takes place every four years and is currently being held in Charlotte, North Carolina (April 24 – May 3).

Delegates from around the world are chosen by their annual conference. The total number of delegates will be between 600 - 1000, with the Indiana Conference sending 15 delegates. The total delegation is comprised of an equal number of clergy and laity.

Long story short, General Conference is a big deal!

Are you keeping up your gratitude journal or remembering to put God first in your day? Are you listening to God when He speaks to you or taps you on the shoulder or sends you a message in some unexpected way? God has a way of getting my attention, and recently it had to do with humbling me about accepting help when it was offered in Christian love.

In April, I was part of a team planning an event at FUMC for 65 people. We all wanted it to be a wonderful time providing an evening meal and a continuing education program for Stephen Ministers from several churches in the area. The Stephen Leaders met several times to plan

the details. At a different meeting, I had 2 Stephen Ministers from our church offer to come early for the event and help. Can you guess what I did? I turned them down – right then and there. Of course, I did thank them for their offer, but thought to myself, "I've got this. I don't need help." They looked surprised, and the meeting went on.

When I got home, different thoughts came to my head. I know it was God speaking to me. He said to me, "Why do you think you can or have to do everything yourself? Why would you turn down friends' offers to help? What if some of the people scheduled to help have something come up, and you find yourself short of helpers? What if the 2 people you turned down were trying to give the gift of showing kindness to ease the task on you and others? Or maybe they wanted to feel useful and part of the group by doing something positive. What if they might have suggestions that you hadn't thought of? What if you discouraged them from ever asking again to help?" Oh, my!!

After talking to God about what was keeping me from sleeping that night, I later called one of them and apologized and then talked to the other person face-to-face. I explained that I was being selfish in not accepting their free and willing help. They graciously accepted my apology, arrived early and stayed late to help clean-up. It was wonderful to see our FUMC Stephen Ministry Team welcome others to our church for fellowship, sharing, and learning. It was also a great learning experience for me and my pride! I am not likely to turn down Christian help again.

This leads me to another way of Christian helping. Stephen Ministry is a wonderful service that our church provides for those who are struggling with much on their minds. We all have issues that are helped by having someone to talk to who will listen non-judgmentally and with a Christian heart. This is what Stephen Ministry provides. Do not be too proud to ask for or receive help. If you are needing someone to talk to on a regular basis to help you and, with God's help, find answers and peace in your life, ask about having a Stephen Minister. We have trained lay people in our church who can provide this. You would be matched 1:1, a man with a man and a woman with a woman. That individual Stephen Minister can walk with you for spiritual encouragement to find the blessings in life that God has waiting for you.
